

Criminal Case Fresh Start Report

FINDING: Based on your answers, you are likely eligible for a nondisclosure order under statute section 411.0731 because you were placed on community supervision (probation) after your DWI.

GUIDANCE: To get this order, there are three steps you need to take:

- 1. Get a copy of your criminal record from <u>Identogo</u>.
- 2. Get a certified copy of your dismissal and discharge order from the clerk of the court that dismissed your case.
- 3. Get a certified copy of your indictment, or "information," document. You should be able to get this from the clerk of the court that handled your case.
- 4. Fill out the nondisclosure guided forms (recommended) for section 411.0731.
- 5. File the completed forms with the court that heard your case.

Once you file the completed application, the court will either grant your application or set a hearing date to determine whether to grant you a nondisclosure order.
