

Criminal Case Fresh Start Report

FINDING: Unfortunately, based on your answers, you are likely not eligible for an expunction at this time because the statute of limitations has not expired for all similar past crimes. You cannot get an expunction if you might still possibly be convicted of a similar past crime. However, you may be eligible for an expunction once the statute of limitations has expired.

Note that in many cases, the time between when charges are filed and the case is dismissed does not count toward the statute of limitations.

GUIDANCE: Once the statute of limitations have expired for all similar past crimes, check again to see if you are eligible for an expunction.
